TESTING PROCEDURES

Entry requirements and eligibility processing may differ depending on the region, but may include, but are not limited to:

- Written police entrance examination
- Physical examination performed by a medical doctor
- Background investigation, to include FBI database & fingerprint records search
- Psychological examination (written & oral)

You may also be required to provide additional documentation not included in this application. You will need to provide picture identification when submitting your packet, and are subject to an immediate wants and warrants record search.

LATERAL TRANSFERS

The New Mexico Rangers does accept direct lateral transfer officers from other law enforcement agencies and military police. To qualify, you must have a current (within 2 years) commission and certification from a state or federal law enforcement agency, in where you completed all required training and possess full arrest authority within your jurisdiction. Additional training is required for all lateral transfers. Please enclose all support documents of your lateral transfer in this application.

NEW MEXICO RANGERS
OMNIBUS CONSOLIDATED APPROPRIATION ACT OF 1997

You are required to read the Omnibus Consolidated Appropriation Act of 1997. You must understand the federal requirements and sign the document qualifying that you have not been accused, charged, or suspected of domestic violence. Any false submission or failure to disclose such can result in disqualification from the New Mexico Mounted Patrol and may qualify for federal prosecution.

The Omnibus Consolidated Appropriations Act of 1997 amended the Federal Gun Control Act, 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(9). Under these provisions, it is unlawful for an individual convicted of a state or federal "misdemeanor crime of domestic violence" to "ship, transport, possess or receive firearms or ammunition."

A "misdemeanor crime of violence," pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 921(33)(a), means an offense that:

has, as an element, the use or attempted use of physical force, or the threatened use of a deadly weapon, committed by a current or former spouse, parent, or guardian of the victim, by a person with whom the victim shares a child in common, by a person who is cohabiting with or has cohabited with the victim as a spouse, parent or guardian, or by a person similarly situated to a spouse, parent, or guardian of the victim.

Law enforcement officers and governmental employees (such as security guards or military personnel) are not exempt from this law with respect to their receipt or possession of firearms or ammunition. Therefore, law enforcement and other government employees who have been convicted of a qualifying misdemeanor will not be able to lawfully possess or receive firearms or ammunition or any purposes, including performing their official duties.

Furthermore, the law makes it unlawful for any person, including governmental agencies, to sell or otherwise issue firearms or ammunition to any person knowing or having reasonable cause to believe that the person has been convicted of a misdemeanor crime of violence.
